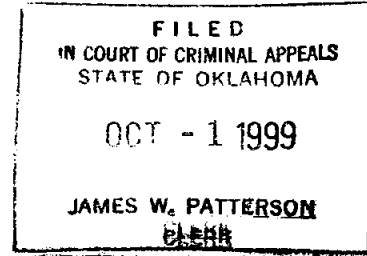

SUMMARY OPINION

LILE, JUDGE:

Appellant, J. F., was adjudicated delinquent after a bench trial in Lincoln County District Court, Case No. JFJ-98-51, before the Honorable David Welch, Associate District Judge. It was found that Appellant had committed acts which would constitute the misdemeanor crime of Injury to an Automobile. Judge Welch continued the case so that a disposition order could be entered at a later date. The order had not been entered at the time of the appeal. From the finding of delinquency, J. F. has perfected this appeal.

Appellant's sole proposition of error on appeal is that the evidence was insufficient to support the adjudication. The evidence showed that all of the testifying juveniles were accomplices. The State, in its brief, does not dispute the fact that all four juveniles were accomplices. There is no evidence, other than the accomplices' testimony to connect Appellant to the roof of the building and to the crime itself. Therefore, this case must be reversed. The law on

accomplices applies to juvenile adjudications. *L.E.Y. v. State*, 1982 OK CR _4, 639 P.2d 1253, 1254-55. “[T]he testimony of one accomplice may not be used to corroborate another.” *Bowie v. State*, 1991 OK CR 78, 816 P.2d 1143, 1146.

DECISION

The adjudication of delinquency entered by the trial court in this case is **REVERSED** and **REMANDED** to the trial court with instructions to **DISMISS**.
